

PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS CR 38 TO CR 142 PROJECT INFORMATION SHEET





The CR 17 Improvement Project is a priority in the Michiana Area Council of Governments (MACOG) 2045 Long-Range Transportation Plan.

PROPOSED 2-LANE IMPROVEMENTS

- Resurface CR 17 south of CR 38 to north of CR 40
- Widen CR 17 to 12-foot lanes with 10-foot paved shoulders from north of CR 40 to south of CR 142
- Generally follow existing alignment, centerline shifts may occur to minimize homestead impacts
- Maintain & reconstruct all driveways
- Upgrade drainage (culverts) & construct 4-foot to 10-foot roadside swales along east and west sides
- Tie drainage into existing streams and County-regulated drains
- Signalize and add turn-lanes at CR 40 & CR 142 Intersections




PROJECT PURPOSE


- Improve the mobility & safety of northbound and southbound traffic in western Elkhart County
- Improve substandard geometry to satisfy the requirements for a Principal Arterial Roadway
- Reduce congestion on nearby roadways, including high-traffic volumes on SR 19 and SR 15
